SRWA Releases Bad River Watershed Report Card

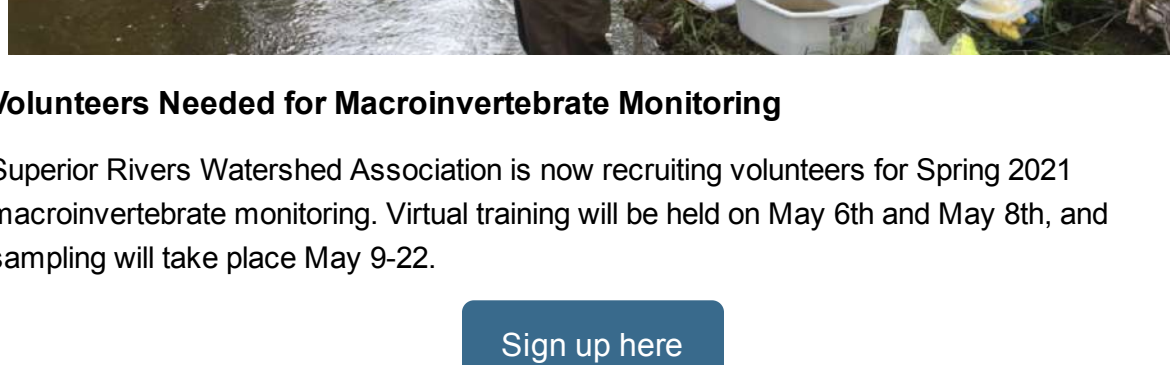
